Letter from Dr Dov Dorfman

Strathfield was a suburban shule which had a variety of ministers for short periods at a time, but when Rabbi Tapoochi came from Sweden, he improved the situation considerably, giving good sermons. He was also a chazan, ba'al koreh and ageneral Zionist minister for all national occasions. The community included young families. It was an orthodox shule in every sense of the word. I took on the presidency when Dr Victor Eppel left for Israel, having been president for a good number of years. I ran the Board and had good relations with the rabbi. I don't recall any major communal problems at the time of my presidency.
